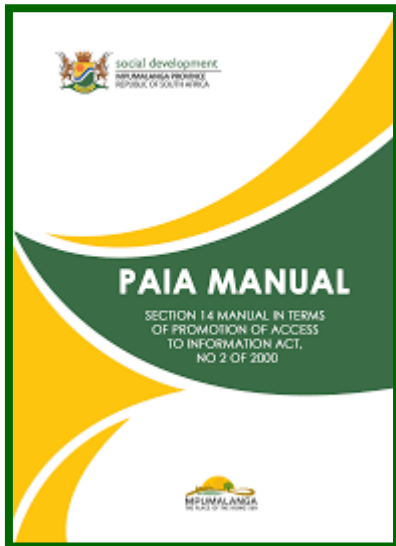

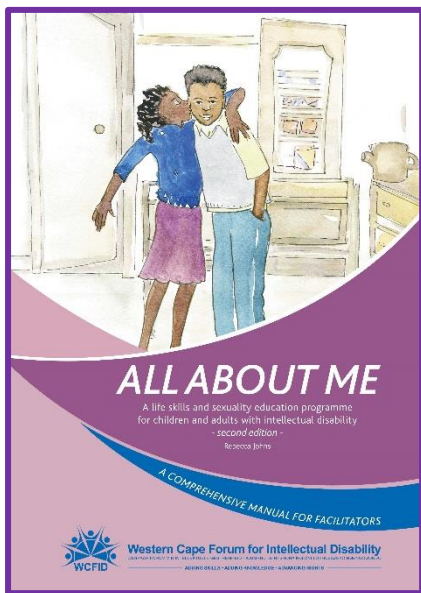

The NEW **All About Me, Life skills and Sexuality Online Course** was launched in September 2021.

Registrations are open until 6 October 2021, and the course will start on 11 October 2021.

This course aims to help teachers, therapists, social workers and caregivers to prepare and present a life skills and sexuality programme to learners and adults with mild to moderate intellectual disability. In this course attendees will learn about a rights based approach to sexuality work, why people with intellectual disability are more vulnerable to abuse, how to teach a client with intellectual disability about their bodies, relationships, their sexual development and so much more. All attendees will receive the new All About Me manual.

Rates for this course are as follows:

- ✚ **Member rate** – R1 000 per person includes book (no CPD points); R1 500 - includes book and CPD points SACE/HPCSA/SACSSP
- ✚ **Non-member rate** – R1 200 per person includes book (no CPD); R2 000 - includes book and CPD points
- ✚ **Members only special** - R3 000 for 2 or more at a school/organisation: includes full set of resources, picture pack + resource pack value of R2 380 .Max of one full set of resources per organisation. Includes CPD points SACE/HPCSA/SACSSP. Does not include individual members.

Right to Protection Training Packs

The 16 Days of Activism for No Violence against Women and Children Campaign (16 Days Campaign) is a United Nations campaign which takes place annually from 25 November (International Day of No Violence against Women) to 10 December (International Human Rights Day).

- ✚ South Africa participates yearly in this campaign, and given the scourge of gender-based violence in the country as well as increased neglect and violence against children, the WCFID has decided to launch a child protection series over this period. We have put together a pack that we would like to make available to your centre as a training tool for your staff and parents alike to raise awareness around child protection for children with intellectual disabilities.
